Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to confirm the arrangements for the summer examination results days in August. Below are the arrangements for the results days this summer for year 10 and 11 respectively. Please take note of the specific timings for collection for each year group.

Year group	Results day arrangements
11	Thursday 20 th August - Students to collect results at (08:30 – 09:30)
10	Thursday 20 th August - Students to collect results at (09:30 – 10:30)

Can you please make sure that you take note of the specific time your child is required to come into school to collect the results. Students will need to come into school through the fire doors to the dining hall as they would during a normal school day at their allocated time. **I must remind you that we can only give out the results of the examinations to the students!** Parents, guardians or friends cannot collect the results for any student unless it has been prearranged with the authorisation of the student.

Any student in year 11 that cannot attend the day needs to contact the exams office. They can then be advised on how to make alternate arrangements so that they can receive their results. If this is the case and your child cannot attend, please email pcs-exams@olympustrust.co.uk informing them of the fact. Again, we can only send the results out to students via email. This email address must be a personal email addressing, belonging to the student only. We cannot send the results to an email address that belongs to parents, guardians or carers.

If your child is a student in year 10 and cannot come in to collect their results, then you will have to wait until school reopens in September to collect them. The results will be available when they return and will be given to them by their tutor, during registration period.
